I Know:

- I know the Bronze Age was after the Stone Age
- I know the Bronze Age was between 3000BC and 1200BC
- I know people in the bronze age discovered how to extract metal from rocks
- I know bronze is made from heating copper and tin at a high temperature (smelting)
- I know they used metal to create better farming equipment, weapons and jewellery
- I know bronze was used to make tools including daggers, blades, spearheads, chisels and axes
- I know people who migrated introduced Britain to pottery 'Bell Beakers'
- I know pottery was used for drinking and smelting metal
- I know bronze age people built stone circles e.g. Stonehenge
- I know they constructed barrows to bury the dead.
