## Lesson Progression:



### **I Know:**

#### **Middle Stone Age (Mesolithic Age)**

- I know the middle Stone Age began at the end of the last ice age 10,000BC.
- I know what everyday life was like for people in the Middle Stone Age e.g. hunting, gathering, fishing, cutting meat and making tools.
- I know middle stone age people were hunter gatherers.
- I know the different type of food they hunted and gathered e.g. dandelions, nettles, eggs, nuts and berries.
- I know how different tools were used for different purposes e.g. handaxe, bow and arrow, spear and harpoon.

#### **New Stone Age (Neolithic Age)**

- I know around 4500BC people came from Europe and began to farm
- I know some features of new stone age life including farming, making pottery and living in big groups.
- I know villages were formed including Skara Brae Village
- I know that people in the Stone Age created paintings in caves.

### **I can:**

- I can ask relevant questions to extend my understanding and knowledge.
- Make close observations of artefacts and use them to make deductions (e.g. I know I think I wonder).
- I can understand and use historical terms such as AD, BCE and civilisation.
- I can carry out research using primary and secondary sources.
