

Michael Rosen Class – Spring Term 1 – Jesus’ Miracles



Key question for this enquiry: Could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?

Learning Objectives: We are learning to retell Bible stories when miracles have happened and question whether Jesus really did perform miracles.

My Vocabulary: Miracle, healing, blind, equipment, rules of nature/expectations, ability, meaningful, incarnation, explanation, leprosy

<p>I Know:</p> <p>I know Christians believe in Jesus.</p> <p>I know Christians believe Jesus is the son of God.</p> <p>I know that Christians believe in the incarnation – that God came to earth in human form as Jesus.</p> <p>I know that a miracle is something that happens outside the usual rules of nature/expectations and Christians believe is caused by God.</p> <p>I know the stories of The Blind Man, Jesus healing diseased people and Jesus healing Simon Peter’s Mother-in-law.</p>	<p>I Can:</p> <p>I can talk about some of the things in the world that people think of as miracles</p> <p>I can begin to tell you about a miracle I would like to see happen today.</p> <p>I can tell at least one of the stories of Jesus’ miracles.</p> <p>I can explain one Christian viewpoint about one of Jesus’ healing miracles.</p> <p>I can start to say whether I believe Jesus actually healed people or not.</p>
