


# Year 5/6 Valerie Bloom Class Autumn Term 1 Islam

## Lesson Progression



**Key Question for this enquiry:** Why is it important to Muslims to show respect to Allah?

**Learning Objectives:** We are learning to understand who Allah and the Prophet Muhammad are to Muslims, and some of the ways Muslims show respect to God.

**My Vocabulary:**

Islam, Muslim, Faith, Allah, Prophet, Muhammad, Qur'an, Profession of faith (shahada). Prayer (salat). Mecca, Alms (zakat). ... Fasting (sawm). Pilgrimage (hajj). Mosque.

- I know Islam is a religion followed by Muslims.
- I know Muslims call God Allah
- I know why Muslims believe Allah is the only God and the most important part of their lives.
- I know why the Qur'an is important to Muslims.
- I know why Muslims have 99 names/attributes for Allah
- I know Islam began when the prophet Muhammed set out Allah's wishes
- I know why Muslims follow the five pillars of Islam
- I know what the five pillars are and may be able to say the Islamic word.
- I know why Allah must not be drawn and why most Muslims do not draw prophets such as Muhammad or Moses



- I can talk about the respect I feel for others and how that might be evident in the way I treat people.
- I can explain the key ways in which Muslims show their respect for Allah.
- I can discuss events in the life of Muhammad and explain the impact of them on the religion of Islam and Muslims today.
- I can consider and explain how a Muslim may feel about the different events in the life of Muhammad.
- I can describe how and why the 5 pillars enable Muslims to show their respect for God and understand that some of these will be more significant to some Muslims than others.
