# Lots different and Lots the same

When you come back to school some things will be different, but lots of things will be the same. Remember:

- You will still have fun
- You will still do your learning
- You will see some of your friends
- Your teachers still care about you very much.

# On the Way In to School



When you come to school in the morning please wait by a cone with your parent or carer. (Only 1 adult to drop off children please).

Everyone will have a different start time, so you will be only waiting with other children in your small group or 'bubble'.

Your teacher will come and collect you and the other children in your bubble- and you will walk to your class room with them.

You may be working with a different teacher and in a different room from usual.

# Taking your temperature



We will take everybody's temperature (staff and children) before they enter the school. We will use a non-contact thermometer at the gate. This will be taken by a member of staff wearing gloves, an apron and a mask. Please try not to talk when you have your temperature taken.

If your temperature is above 38 degrees centigrade we will ask you to go home and stay at home for at least 7 days.

You may need to have a test to see whether you have the coronavirus.

# Washing your hands



**At least 6 times a day**

You will wash your hands as soon as you get to your classroom and lots of other times in the school day. You will wash your hands before and after snacks, before and after lunch and before and after play.

There will also be hand sanitiser gel to use in every class.

# Lunches and water bottles



Everyone will have their own water bottle provided by school. This will have your name on. It will stay in school and be washed on a hot wash in the dishwasher at the end of each day. You will also have a school packed lunch. It is very important that we do not have lots of things coming into school from lots of people's houses. Therefore you will not be allowed to bring your own packed lunch or water bottle from home. You will eat lunch in your class with your 'bubble and your teacher.

# Moving around school



We have made much more space in the corridor for people to move around. Everyone will stick to the left hand side (like on the roads) to make sure they give people plenty of room when they need to pass

All the classroom doors will be open so that you will not need to touch them when you come in and out of the class.

# Social distancing in the classroom



You will stay in the same class with your bubble. There will be no more than 6 children in your class at the moment.

You will do nearly all your work at your desk.

You can see that there is lots of space (more than 2m) between the desks.

We will also keep all the windows open so that there is lots of fresh air.

# Catch it, bin it, kill it!



If anyone coughs or sneezes we will make sure they **'catch it, bin it, kill it'**.

Catch your sneeze or cough in a tissue, put it in the bin and wash your hands thoroughly.

We have new pedal bins in every class for tissues.

# Your own equipment

You will have your own set of stationary so you do not have to share.





You will also have your own art materials and your own maths resources.

Every week you will get a set of reading books- which have not these will not have been touched by any other children for a week.

We are doing everything we can to make sure that no germs are spread by sharing equipment

# Playtimes



At playtimes you will play with the other children in your 'bubble' in your own part of the playground. It is really important that you stay with your teacher in your special area.

You will wash your hands before and after lunch .

Each bubble will have their own set of equipment to play with- and we will wash these after every playtime.

# Going to the toilet



Each bubble will only share toilets with one or two other bubbles. This means there will not be many people sharing the toilet facilities (5 toilets between no more than 18 children).

The toilets will be cleaned at least 4 times a day- before your playtime, before lunchtime, after lunch and at the end of the day.

Only one child will be allowed in the bathroom at a time- and everyone will wait outside 2m metres apart.

# Your Learning

You will have two days of lessons with your teacher. In that time you will have:

- Two reading lessons
  - Two writing lessons
  - Two maths lessons
  - 1 PE lesson
  - 1 science lesson
  - 1 art lesson
  - 1 PSHE lesson
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- Your teacher will then set some follow up work for you to do at home. (This will be very like the learning packs you have already been doing). You should do that learning before you come back to school the next week.



# PE



You will have 1 PE lesson a week with your bubble and this will be outside wherever possible.

Each bubble will have its own set of PE equipment, which will not be shared with other groups. All PE equipment, including mats, will be carefully cleaned after you have used them.

PE will be taught through activities which allow social distancing- and there will be absolutely no contact sports.

# Close Contact and First aid



If a grown up needs to be close to you- for example you hurt yourself or are poorly, they will put on some special equipment to make sure everyone is safe. They will wear goggles and masks, gloves and an apron. They may ask you to wear a mask too.




# Assemblies

We will have an assembly- remotely using Microsoft Teams- every Tuesday and Friday. Miss Adams will lead the assembly and you will take part in your classrooms. You will see Mrs Adams on your IWB and Mrs Adams will be able to see you- so you will be able to talk to each other.

In these assemblies we will be able to share news and celebrate the achievements of people who have been trying really hard, just like we always do. You will get an- e- certificate sent to your families instead of a paper one.

# Rewards and Consequences

## Rewards and Celebrations....

### If you are a positive member of the community, we will:

- allowing you to collectively accrue extra playtime points with your 'bubble'
- hold an end of week celebration time to highlight success of individuals.
- Keep your parents informed of your great effort, care and work



## Consequences....

### If you do not follow our behaviour rules, you will:

- Receive a reminder to 'bubble' or a verbal warning, depending on the situation.
- Receive a short sanction, such as missed playtime, followed by a discussion with an adult about your choices
- Have a meeting with your parent
- Be collected immediately or your place will be lost
- Be asked to stay away from Oasis Academy Longmeadow until it is deemed appropriate that you may return.



# Keeping things clean

We will be doing lots of cleaning in school to keep everything clean.



- The play equipment you use at lunchtime and for PE will be cleaned after you use it.
- Toilets will be cleaned 4 times a day
- Your classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned twice a day
- There will be cloths and virucidal spray in every classroom so teachers can quickly clean surfaces
- In Reception children will wash their hands before and after using play equipment. Play equipment will be cleaned at lunchtime and new resources used in the afternoon.
